### **Congratulations!**

With your help, The Hampshire House has earned EPA's ENERGY STAR for for 2019! But, what does that mean, exactly?

### The mark of efficiency...

The ENERGY STAR label means that we are an energy-efficient top performer that saves money without sacrificing performance. To be certified as ENERGY STAR, a building must meet strict energy performance standards set by EPA.

### Certified buildings save...

ENERGY STAR certified buildings save energy, save money, and help protect the environment by generating fewer greenhouse gas emissions than typical buildings.



To be eligible for ENERGY STAR certification, a building must earn an ENERGY STAR score of 75 or higher, indicating that it performs better than at least 75 percent of similar buildings nationwide. It's an annual certification that must be verified by a third-party engineer. Congrats!



#### Dear Tenant Shareholders:

Happy New Year! 2019 is ending with only a slight chill in the air but no snow on the ground! However, I hope the updates in this letter will warm fellow Tenant Shareholders.

Operating Budget: The operating budget for 2020, approved by the Board of Directors, provides a four percent (4%) increase in maintenance for this coming year. This modest increase will offset the increases in property taxes and union payroll and wages. The Hampshire House continues to meet the criteria specified in the budget for both operating income and expenses, primarily due to other income, and from the flip tax generated by the sale of apartments. The flip tax has been enormously helpful in holding off higher maintenance increases over the past ten years without impacting the level of services that we expect while building the reserve fund.

<u>Energy</u>: You have all seen articles in recent years speaking to the rising costs of heat, light, power, property taxes, and labor costs, and you realize these are the realities of fixed costs in New York City. Projects like our energy conversion will continue to fight against this rising tide of costs, and we have much to be proud of in our recent award of the Energy Star! Turning off air conditioners when you leave home has a remarkably positive effect on the overall operations of the building.

Real Estate: According to a recent NY Times article, the current sales market remained flat with a slight uptick predicted in 2020 - most likely to mirror 2019 in length of time apartments are on the market before closing. Sellers who have priced their apartments appropriately will see quicker results, as this is a buyers' market. Real estate around the park continues to be the most desired in Manhattan. In past years, you have initiated many of our qualified purchasers. As the overall real estate market continues to improve, you may have friends who would be interested in knowing the availability of apartments. <u>Proforma for the Future</u>: In 2020 the board of directors will be building a five-year proforma to bring us into the new decade. There are several critical events, like the expiration of the Exhale lease and the underlying mortgage happening within that time period that will be addressed. As always, the success of these programs depends on your support and participation.

<u>Housekeeping</u>: The removal of the cement that was splashed on the Hampshire House as well as other locations in the area continues. This project is expected to take approximately another 14 months. During this time, there will be pipe scaffolding erected in and around parts of the building. This is necessitated by the Deptartment of Buildings as well as the scope of work. We will keep everyone updated on the progress and the disruptions due to this unfortunate by necessary work.

<u>The Shelter</u>: The proposed opening of a homeless shelter on 58<sup>th</sup> street directly behind the south entrance of the Essex House continues to be successfully thwarted. A group of area tenants and merchants who oppose this installation have formed the West 58<sup>th</sup> street Coalition to act as the umbrella group to represent the surrounding community. To date, we have been successful in our efforts and we have been sending out regular updates by email and our Hampshire House Newsletter (<u>www.150cps.com</u>). An appearance before the Appellate Division judges is scheduled to take place sometime in January.


### Local Events Here Now or Coming Soon!

#### Winter HVAC Care

The best way to protect your thru-wall AC/Heat unit is to install winter boards in the sleeve.

If you spend little or no time in-house during winter then the best bet is to make sure the unit is in the OFF mode.

If you are here during the cold months then the unit must remain ON and in the heat mode


Trouble starts during severe cold snaps when the units are turned on and off trapping condensate in coil and freezing it.

A winter board will protect you from making a mistake during the cold weather.
